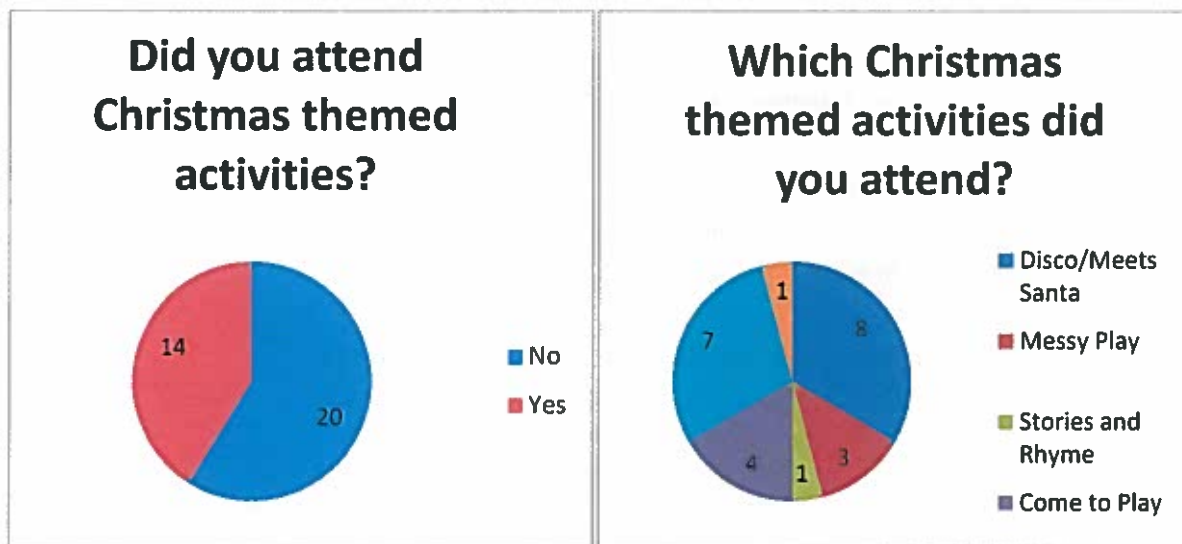
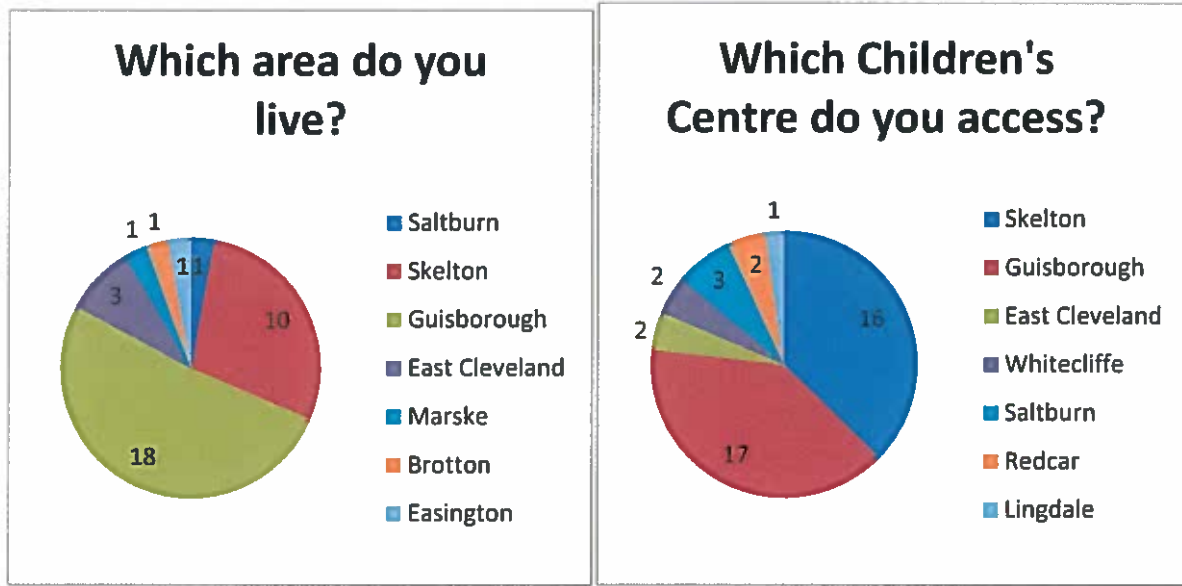


East Locality – Parent Participation Feb-2017

Which Activities did you enjoy the most and why?
