



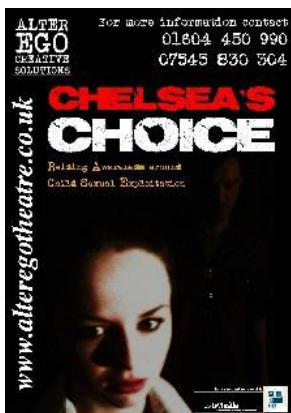

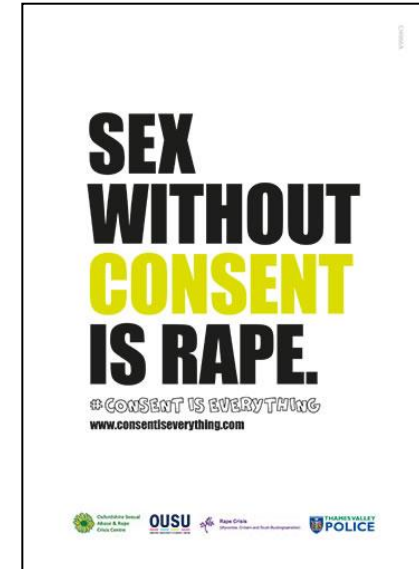
### Tea and Consent
