



COVID-19 Update February 2021

Use of Redcar and Cleveland’s Children’s Hubs and Youth and Community Centres

A number of Redcar and Cleveland’s Centres will re-open from **1st July 2020** for use by **Personal Assistants while looking after disabled children and young people**. These sessions are free of charge and are subject to availability. Sessions must be booked in advance by either parent/carers or the PAs. This is to ensure the safety of children and young people visiting the centre.

Due to a number of children and young people still not being able to access school, in the interim, sessions will be available during the day in term time as well as school holidays.

In line with Government Guidance to reduce the risk of the transmission of infections, sessions will only be able to take place when the centre is not in use and some equipment and toys have had to be removed. Therefore, we would advise PAs to bring their own toys/equipment.

All centres have an accessible entrance and toilet, but kitchens will not be available due to infection control measures in place.
