Standards

- Only one household bin will be emptied per property.
- Lids on all wheeled bins must be closed.
- Bags put out with wheeled bins will not be collected and may be regarded as a littering offence for which fines may be issued.
- Your wheeled bin will be emptied anytime between 7am and 7pm. Please put your bin out before 7am and return it to your property after collection the same day
- Your wheeled bin will not be emptied if you do not follow these standards.

Help us to keep crime down and your street clean and tidy by securing your bin or keeping it out of sight.

Putting your bin out on the wrong day or leaving it out after it has been emptied increases the risk of arson and it may tell thieves that your home is empty.

You could also be fined for ignoring the standards set.
