

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXTEND AND VARY THE REDCAR & CLEVELAND BOROUGH
COUNCIL (GATES) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2017
ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014, SECTIONS 60 AND 61**

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council ("the Council") hereby gives notice of its intention to extend and vary the above Public Spaces Protection Order under sections 60 and 61 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act").

- (a) the requirements of Section 59 and 60 in respect of the said highways are satisfied; and.
- (b) that it is expedient for the purposes of preventing or reducing crime and/or anti-social behaviour that public use of the said highways be restricted as this Order provides.

The Council of the Borough of Redcar and Cleveland in exercise of its powers under Section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

The Order shall be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Alcohol) Public Spaces Protection Order 2017.

General provisions:

- (c) A person who fails to comply with any obligation imposed by this order is guilty of a criminal offence by virtue of section 63(6) of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and liable to a fine on summary conviction not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
 - (d) A person guilty of an offence under section 63 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.
1. The Order shall come into operation on 20th October 2017 and shall have effect for a period of 3 years hereafter unless varied or discharged by further orders.
 2. The places to be restricted ('Restricted Area') are detailed in the schedule attached.
 3. The Order allows a constable or an authorised person, if he reasonably believes that a person has consumed or intends to consume alcohol in a Restricted Area, to require that person not to consume in that area the alcohol or to surrender in his possession any alcohol or a container for such alcohol. A constable or authorised person may dispose of anything surrendered to him in such manner as he considers appropriate.
 4. The Order makes it an offence for a person at any time to urinate and/or defecate without reasonable excuse for doing so on or within the Restricted Areas to which this order applies.
 5. The Order is made because the Council is satisfied that the requirements of Section 59 of the Act in respect of the Restricted Areas are satisfied and that it is expedient for the purposes of preventing or reducing crime and/or anti-social behaviour that public use of the Restricted Areas as detailed in the attached schedule be restricted.
 6. If any person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in

relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which this Order is made.

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council in exercising its power under sections 60(2)(a), 61 (1)(b) and 61 (2) of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 intend to extend the order, with variations, for a period of 3 years expiring on 19 October 2023. The extension and variations are necessary to prevent the occurrence or reoccurrence of the activities identified in the order.

Copies of the draft Order and maps may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Kirkleatham Street, Redcar, Yorkshire TS10 1RT between 09:00 and 17:00 Monday to Friday of any working week. Any representations or objections as to whether the proposed order should be extended may be sent in writing to the council's prevention and partnership officer at Redcar & Cleveland House, Kirkleatham Street, Redcar, Yorkshire TS10 1RT, not later than 9 October 2020. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may still extend the Order if it is appropriate for it to do so.
