South Tees Area Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (As amended), notice is hereby given that the South Tees Area Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council on the 24th May 2018.

The SPD will provide guidance to support the delivery of economic development within the South Tees Area. The SPD will be a material consideration in determining planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the document. The application must be made to the High Court in a prompt manner and in any case not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted, that is by the 16th August 2018.

Under Section 23 (1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, the Council has modified the SPD to take into account representations made in relation to the document and any other relevant matters. Modifications are included in the Statement of Consultation.
