Redcar and Cleveland Early Years' Integrated Service Family Hubs and Health Visitors Together

IN REDCAR & CLEVELAND

we are in a unique position because the staff in our Health Visiting and Family Hub services are now working more together to support you and your family through the healthy child programme and the first 5 years of their lives. Both the health visiting and the family hub teams will be in contact with you during the antenatal period and within the first weeks of your baby being born.

This leaflet explains the support available to you and your family from both teams throughout these crucial years of childhood to ensure your child has the best start in life. We hope you find this information helpful, if you have any queries please don't hesitate to contact us on the telephone numbers overleaf.

All children and families will be invited to have a health and development progress review at key milestone ages. At each of these key stages, a member of the team will be in contact with you to assess and review progress and if at any time your child or yourself needs any extra help, we will ensure you get the right support. The key stages are identified within the Early Years Pathway in the middle of the leaflet.

In our integrated service, we focus on the 6 High Impact Areas for Early Years – these are the areas as follows:

- Parenthood and early weeks
- Maternal mental health
- Breast feeding
- Healthy weight
- Minor illness and accidents
- Healthy 2 years old and getting ready for school

The activities available in our Family Hubs are detailed below

Activities will be delivered virtually to families; in smaller groups in centres or individually whilst we are still in the midst of the national response to COVID-19. Your Family Hub practitioner will advise you about the best ways we can support you and deliver these sessions at the time you are referred.

Breast Friends - Breast Feeding Support Group

From pregnancy onwards • Breastfeeding mums welcome • Ongoing sessions throughout the year


A social group for breastfeeding families with planned fun activities. Come along for a chat and get to know other breastfeeding families in the area. Support is also available from our trained staff. We also welcome pregnant parents-to-be.

Chat, Sing and Read at Home

0-5-year olds • Referral only • Delivered 1:1 • Time Limited – 6 weeks

A package to support attachment, relationships, developmental delay, play rolemodelling and support to improve the home learning environment. The health visiting team will refer to this programme after completing your child's 9-12 month or at their 24-27-month development check if they feel your child needs further support.

EARLY YEARS INTEGRATED PATHWAY



Early Years Parenting Support programme

0-5-year olds • Referral only • Delivered 1:1 • Time Limited – 6 weeks

For 0-5-year olds – providing parents with basic support, guidance and information for example routines and boundaries; choices and consequences. The package of support will be tailored to the individual family's needs.

HENRY

Age 0-5 years ● Referral only ● Time limited – 8 weeks (HENRY: Health, Exercise and Nutrition for the Really Young)

HENRY supports families in choosing healthy lifestyles including making healthy food choices for their children and gives carers ideas for lots of fun ways to get children moving.

Infant Massage

6 weeks - 6 months • Referral only • Time limited - 4 weeks

Infant massage promotes secure attachments and early bonding as well as supporting infant health and development; and helps with sleep routines and colic. The programme also helps with reducing low mood and social isolation in parents. The course is facilitated by a qualified infant massage instructor.

Little Explorers

Ongoing sessions throughout the year • Age 0-3 years • Everyone welcome

An opportunity to play together and meet other families from the local community. Activities available for babies and young children to play, explore and learn.

New Parents Group

Birth - 9 months • Everyone welcome

An open access group for new parents who have recently had a baby. Support and discussion around baby's brain development, sensory play, sleep, routines and general advice and guidance. A chance to chat with other new mums.

Portage Family Group

From 6 weeks onwards • Referral only

Portage groups offer support to children with complex needs and their families. This includes arranging assessments with other professionals, and setting targets to improve outcomes and make learning easier. The groups are ran by a team of Early Years SEND practitioners who are fully qualified childcare and portage professionals and who can offer a key-working service to coordinate services and support for the family.

Starting Solids - HENRY

4-6 months • Everyone welcome • Time Limited – 1 session

Introducing solid foods at 6 months. Come to a Starting Solids workshop to help you get your baby off to a great start. The workshop will help you decide when your baby is ready to try solid food, what foods to start with, when your baby is hungry and when they've had enough; and how to make mealtimes an enjoyable experience for both of you.

Wriggle, Read and Rhyme with Book Start

Age 2 years+ • Requires booking through children's centres • Time limited – 5 weeks

Sessions for carers to attend with their child aged 2 – 4 years. These sessions aim to support communication language and literacy development by encouraging a love of books stories and rhymes.
