The South Tees Changing Futures programme is a joint initiative in Middlesbrough and Redcar & Cleveland, working in partnership to better support those in society who experience multiple disadvantages.

## **Eligibility**:

Futures

The person must be over the age of 18, not currently residing with dependants under the age of 16 and must be experiencing two or more of the following:

- Experiencing domestic abuse
- Homelessness / acute housing issue
- Substance or alcohol misuse
- Mental health issues
- Repeated contact with the criminal justice system

If you are working with someone who you think would benefit from a dedicated key worker to help them navigate local statutory and voluntary sector support systems, referrals can be made as follows:
