



REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT) ORDER NO 1 2022

The Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act") the effect of which will be to amend the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Order") so that overnight camping is permitted provided the required payment is made.

The Council has also made an Order under the Act the effect of which will be to amend the Order by adding Cowbar Lane Car Park to it making it a pay and display car park with the following charges:-

Between 08:00 and 18:00 hours Up to 2 hours £2.00, 3 hours £3.00, 4 hours £4.00, over 4 hours £6.00.
Between 18:00 and 08:00 hours overnight charge £15.00.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or any provision in them on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to them, you may, within 6 weeks from 10.1.23 apply to the High Court for that purpose.

The Council of the Borough of Redcar and Cleveland (hereinafter called the “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called “The Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act , hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on the 16th day of January 2023 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places)(Consolidation)(Amendment)Order (No 2)2022

2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council(Off Street parking Places)(Consolidation)Order 2003 (“the Order”) is hereby amended as follows:-
