- 1 This Order shall come into operation on the day of 202 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order (No. 1) 2023.
- 2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2003 ("the Order") is hereby amended by revoking the following from Schedule 6.22

The Crescent the south-west side from a point 5 metres south of its junction with Sycamore Road for a distance of 195 metres in a south-easterly direction.

3. The Order is hereby amended by adding the following to Schedule 6.22 Resident Parking Bay Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Zone Y

The Crescent

- (i) From a point 5 metres south east of its junction with Sycamore Road, to a point 44.6 metres south east of its intersection with the extended joint property boundary of 16 & 17 The Crescent
- (ii) .(ii) the south side from a point 18 metres west of its junction with Coast Road, to its intersection with the extend western property boundary of number 21 The Crescent.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The traffic regulation order is required to revoke the resident parking restriction currently in place on the central parking bay at The Crescent Redcar to allow parking for those wishing to attend the church or access the parks and allotments. The resident bays either side directly outside of the residential properties will remain as resident only.

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
