#### **Background to Decision:**

In support of the Council's SEND strategy and identification of a shortfall of nursery places in the Borough for pupils with Special Education Needs and Disabilities (SEND), the provision of additional nursery provision in adequately resourced settings is being sought.

Kilton Thorpe Academy propose to establish a new 10 place specialist assessment nursery provision in a new build standalone unit on their main school site in Brotton. This will provide parents with increased choice and help plug gaps in provision, particularly in East Cleveland. The project has been developed in conjunction with the Council's SEND team and will help increase the number of places that the team can place children into.

On 23.9.2022, a Delegated Authority was approved in awarding Kilton Thorpe Academy £250,000 toward the development of the nursery.

#### **Decision Considerations:**

The school are currently underway with developing a standalone block that will free up space to enable the development of the proposed dedicated nursery. The new nursery design has been fully designed and tenders let through a competitive process. These have returned in excess of the original budget available. While a full review and value engineering exercise will be undertaken, there is expected to remain a funding gap over that available.

Therefore, in order to fully fund the works, and ensure it is delivered on time to see the planned provision in place by September 2023, it is proposed that up to an additional £120,000 be made available. This would be through a variation to the existing funding agreement.

#### Full details of decision:

To increase the existing funding agreement from £250,000 to a maximum of £370,000 to help cover increased project costs following competitive tendering.

#### Financial detail:

Provide additional grant funding of up to £120,000 toward the agreed nursery project. Grant funding will thus be to a maximum total of £370,000 and is to be made available from the High Needs Capital Grant Fund allocation, which is a Department for Education grant to the Council for development of SEND places. The project is in line with the grant criteria.

#### **Delivering Social Value:**

The project will provide further capacity and quality or provision to support parents and pupils within the Borough identified as being in need of places that will be made available and enhanced. The recipient has sought tenders from local construction companies, as required in the funding agreement.

#### **Reasons for Decision:**

To enable the development of a 10 place SEND nursery, which is an identified need in the Borough.

None deliverable at this time.

Officers are constantly reviewing potential opportunities to create appropriate provision with partner providers, from which this provision has been developed.
