Telecare provides support to people living in the community and the current contract expires on 31st March 2023. Discussions have taken place over recent weeks to re-model the service and agree terms for an interim contract period to develop the service leading up to digitalisation. Authorisation is sought to engage in an interim contract with Beyond Housing for a period of 12 months with the option to extend for a further period of 12 months through a Direct Award under the Northern Housing Consortium Framework. The contract value is estimated to be £630,000 per year.

Background to decision:

Telecare provides 24hr access to support for people living in their own homes and has been used for a number of years. It has a preventative role in providing an immediate point of contact and addressing risks that can help to reduce and delay reliance on more restrictive and intensive models of care and support. This ensures that people retain increased choice and control over remaining in their own homes and increases the efficiency and effectiveness of local care and support services.

Decision Considerations:

A new generation of digitalised technology is to be introduced over the next two years and effective partnership working will be required to transition to new systems and implement increasing and improving options for Telecare.

Full details of decision:

Approval is requested to award a contract to Beyond Housing to provide a Telecare service in Redcar and Cleveland from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024 (with the option to extend for a further 12 months).

The contract will be awarded to Beyond Housing via direct award using Lot 3.1 of the Technology Enabled Care Services framework via Consortium Procurement (Northern Housing Consortium).

Financial detail:

The contract value is estimated to be £630,000 per year. The total contract value for the initial year and with the optional 12-month extension is estimated to be £1,260,000.

Delivering Social Value:

Telecare enables residents to remain in their own homes as active citizens in the community.

Reasons for Decision:

Telecare provides direct care and support to people in their own homes and is an integral part of the wider care and support system, providing efficient and effective use of resources.

Beyond Housing were appointed to the Technology Enabled Care Services framework via Consortium Procurement (Northern Housing Consortium) after a full tender process was carried out.
