REDCAR(WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES)CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT)ORDER NO 2 2023

The Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is to amend the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Redcar)(Waiting and Loading and Parking Places)Consolidation Order 2003 by introducing no waiting at any time restrictions on the roads specified in the Schedule below.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision in it on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 18.9.23 apply to the High Court for that purpose.

Schedule

A1042 Kirkleatham Lane the east side from a point 57 metres south of its junction with Kirkleatham Lane (Village) for a distance of 123 metres in a northerly direction.

Kirkleatham Lane the east side from its junction with the southern boundary of West Lodge access road to a point 29 metres north of the access road to Kirkleatham Hall School; the north-west side from its junction with A1042 Kirkleatham Lane, to a point 20 metres south of its junction with the access to the cottages (south of St. Cuthbert's Church); the south-east side from its junction with A1042 Kirkleatham Lane, to a point 24 metres south of the access road to Kirkleatham Hall School; the west side from a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to the cottages (south of St. Cuthbert's Church); the south-east side from its junction with A1042 Kirkleatham Lane, to a point 24 metres south of the access road to Kirkleatham Hall School; the west side from a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to the cottages (south of St. Cuthbert's Church) to its intersection with the northern boundary of West Lodge access road.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Concerns have been raised with regards to the safety of road users due to obstructive parking at Kirkleatham Village particularly around Sir William Turners Court and Kirkleatham School resulting in passing vehicles crossing the solid white centre line into oncoming traffic.

Therefore, to address the concerns raised it is proposed to implement no waiting at any time restrictions on both sides from A1042 Kirkleatham Lane to just north of Kirkleatham School. It is proposed to leave the area at the school access free from restrictions to allow an area for vehicles to park when visiting the school and church. There is also free parking available at Kirkleatham Walled Garden and Kirkleatham Museum.

The Council of the Borough of Redcar and Cleveland (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 47, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 29th day of September 2023, and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Redcar) (Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order (No 2) 2023
- The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Redcar)(Waiting and Loading and Parking 2. Places)Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Order") is hereby amended by inserting the following into Schedule 1 No Waiting at Any Time

A1042 Kirkleatham Lane the east side from a point 57 metres south of its junction with Kirkleatham Lane (Village)for a distance of 123 metres in a northerly direction.

Kirkleatham Lane

- the east side from its junction with the southern boundary of West Lodge access (i) road to a point 29 metres north of the access road to Kirkleatham Hall School
- the north-west side from its junction with A1042 Kirkleatham Lane, to a point 20 (ii) metres south of its junction with the access to the cottages (south of St. Cuthbert's Church)
- the south-east side from its junction with A1042 Kirkleatham Lane, to a point 24 (iii) metres south of the access road to Kirkleatham Hall School
- the west side from a point 20 metres north of its junction with the access to the (iv)cottages (south of St. Cuthbert's Church) to its intersection with the northern boundary of West Lodge access road
