

NOTICE OF POLLING DISTRICTS & POLLING STATION REVIEW

Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

Section 17 of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 introduced a duty on local authorities to “carry out and complete” reviews of polling districts and polling places at least every five years. The last review in Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council took place between October and November 2018.

To comply with this duty, the review in Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council started consultations with its own elected members and we are now seeking views from interested parties and residents. You can submit your views between Monday 2nd October and Tuesday 31st October 2023.

The review will seek to establish how suitably placed the polling stations are within each electoral area making specific reference to both disability and accessibility issues.

We would welcome representations or comments on the authority’s proposals from any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability and would also welcome suggestions for alternative sites.

The Returning Officer’s proposals for the new polling districts and suitability of polling stations will be published by Friday 1st December 2023 and will be available for inspection in Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council libraries and on the council’s website www.redcar-cleveland.gov.uk.
