Urgent – General Exception - Reasons for urgency outlined below

Telecare provides support to people living in the community and the current contract expired on 31st March 2023. An interim contract was sought through the Northern Housing consortium however it come to light that the service we have from them and still require going forward does not fall under the remit of the Telecare framework. Discussions have taken place over recent weeks to re-model the service and agree terms for an interim contract period to develop the service leading up to digitalisation. Authorisation is sought to engage in an interim contract with Beyond Housing for a period of 12 months. The contract value is estimated to be £480,000 per year.

Background to decision:

Authorisation is sought to award a contract with Beyond Housing to allow continuity of service as the current contract for the delivery of Telecare with Beyond Housing expired on 31 March 2023. There are currently 2123 residents using this service. The transition to a digital service is progressing, and more innovative solutions, options and conversations are still being undertaken on what this will look like in the future.

Telecare reduces the risks associated with living at home for older people, people with dementia and people with disabilities. It also provides reassurance to their family and carers, and by empowering self-management, and enabling individuals to age well at home for longer we are likely to reduce or delay the need for higher cost care services.

The Care Act 2014 highlights prevention as one of seven key responsibilities for local authorities, with an inextricable link to the fundamental principle of promoting wellbeing.

Decision Considerations:

A new generation of digitalised technology is to be introduced over the next two years and effective partnership working will be required to transition to new systems and implement increasing and improved options for Technology based services. Awarding a contract to Beyond Housing for telecare monitoring and response service will allow on-going discussions to remodel and develop the service leading up to this digitalisation.

Full details of decision:

Approval is requested to award a contract to Beyond Housing for the delivery of a Telecare Monitoring and Response Service.

Contract period: 12 months - 1 April 2023 – 31 March 2024

Financial detail:

12 months Contract Value - £480,000.00

Budget resource to be met from the Social Care Budget 10040 R5500

Delivering Social Value:

Social Value is delivered as part of the service. The Provider will be encouraged to sign up to the Councils Social Value Charter.

Reasons for Decision:

The Telecare service in Redcar & Cleveland has proven to be a success since implementation of the contract with Beyond Housing. They are currently providing support to 2123 residents with Redcar & Cleveland. There is a proven track record of support to residents, preventing hospital admission and also reducing the number of residents that may have transitioned to Residential Care or Extra Care housing.

Awarding a contract for 12 months to Beyond Housing for telecare monitoring and response service will allow the continuation of the service whilst allowing on-going discussions to remodel and develop the service leading up to digitalisation.

Details of alternative options considered (if any) and reasons for rejection:

Do Nothing – Rejected as Telecare Services reduces the risks associated with living at home for older people, people with dementia and people with disabilities.

Call off from a framework – An interim contract was sought through the Northern Housing Consortium Telecare Services framework, however it come to light that the service we have from them and still require going forward does not fall under the remit of the framework.
