# THE REDCAR & CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR AND NUISANCE) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2017

Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council ('the council') being the appropriate local authority and in pursuance of its powers under the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, made a Public Spaces Protection Order on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2017, as shown below.

The Council, in its capacity as local authority and pursuance of the s60 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and all other enabling powers, extended this original order until 19<sup>th</sup> October 2026.

The order shall now be cited as the Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council (Anti-social Behaviour and Nuisance) Public Spaces Protection Order 2017 with the following provisions:-

# General provisions:

- (a) A person who fails to comply with any obligation imposed by this order is guilty of a criminal offence by virtue of section 63(6) and section 67 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and liable to a fine on summary conviction not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
- (b) A person guilty of an offence under section 63 and section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.
- 1. The places to be restricted ('Restricted Area') are detailed in the schedule attached.
- 2. The Order allows a constable or an authorised person, if he reasonably believes that a person has consumed or intends to consume alcohol in a Restricted Area, to require that person not to consume in that area the alcohol or to surrender in his possession any alcohol or a container for such alcohol. A constable or authorised person may dispose of anything surrendered to him in such manner as he considers appropriate.
- 3. The Order makes it an offence for a person at any time to urinate and/or defecate without reasonable excuse for doing so on or within the Restricted Areas to which this order applies.
- 4. The order makes it an offence for any person, at any time, to place themselves in a position to beg or solicit money in a manner which is aggressive or intimidating, or which is likely to cause a member of the public to feel harassed, alarmed or distressed, within the Restricted Areas to which this order applies.
- 5. This order makes it an offence for any person being alone or part of a group within the Restricted Areas to which this order applies from making any aggressive verbal, non-verbal or written requests for goods, money or donations.

- 6. The order makes it an offence for any person to act/acts in such a way which causes or is likely to cause alarm, harassment, distress, or nuisance to the public, including people living in the locality, in particular shouting and swearing at, or abusing, threatening or otherwise intimidating (including by the use of sexual language or making sexual suggestions) another person.
- 7. The order makes it an offence for a person who has previously been warned regarding their behaviour under subsection (6) who refuses to leave any highway, car park, open/amenity space area, public toilets, shopping precinct [retail, commercial or licensed premises, public building] or other area within the 'restricted area' when requested to do so by a Police Constable or an Authorised Person.
- 8. The Order is made because the Council is satisfied that the requirements of Section 59 of the Act in respect of the Restricted Areas are satisfied and that it is expedient for the purposes of preventing or reducing crime and/or anti-social behaviour that public use of the Restricted Areas as detailed in the attached schedule be restricted.
- 9. **Exemptions** A person may collect money, in a non-aggressive manner, if they are authorised to do so by a Street Collection Permit issued by the Council.
- 10. If any person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date on which this Order is made.
