Urgent – General Exception - Reasons for urgency outlined below


As part of the Levelling Up Partnership funding allocation, DLUHC has agreed to fund the acquisition and refurbishment of 14 properties by Beyond Housing to use as supported accommodation for care leavers. This proposal is for a purchase and repair scheme, in partnership with Beyond Housing who as a partner will contribute £1.2m to the project.

The urgency is in the spending of the LuP funding which must be achieved by 31.03.2025 and is time critical for Beyond Housing to agree, and confirm their element of funding, for formal agreements to be drawn up and the project to deliver in time scales.
