Carers Assessments and Support Services

Does a partner, family member or friend rely on you for care and support? 🗸

Does the person you care for live in Redcar & Cleveland (R&C)?

Did you know you are an **unpaid carer** and entitled to a **Carers Assessment** from Redcar & Cleveland Borough Council (RCBC) to support you in your caring role. There are also local carer support services that can help you.

Where to start?

Contact the Adult Social Care Access Team at RCBC on **01642 771500** to request a Carers Assessment.

(You can request this at any time during your caring journey and the person you care for does NOT need to be receiving care services for you to qualify).

A carers assessment will be arranged and carried out by a social care practitioner, in person or by phone, whatever you are most comfortable with.

You'll discuss how caring affects your life, including your mental and physical health, work, finances, and relationships.
