## a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)

We are writing to request a variation to our existing licence. The only change we wish to make is to include the marque area and container bar as part of the licensed premises.

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- A minimum of two SIA-badged security staff will always be present in the fanzone and bar area.
- All staff are trained on Challenge 25 and the Ask for Angela initiative.
- CCTV will cover the area, with footage available to the police on request.
- Anyone found in possession of, or using, illegal drugs will be removed from the premises and reported to the police.
- Anyone who is too intoxicated will be refused service, and their details will be recorded in a logbook.

#### c) Public safety

- One SIA-badged staff member will be stationed at the marquee entrance with a click counter to monitor capacity.
- Although the marquee has a capacity of 450 people, we will limit entry to a maximum of 350 to ensure safety and comfort.
- Two emergency exits have been installed to allow safe and orderly evacuation, reducing the risk of overcrowding or panic in an emergency.
- Anyone who appears too intoxicated will be escorted to the first aid point in the changing room area for assessment before further action is taken.
- If a child is reported missing, we will stop the music and make an announcement over the microphone. Stewards will monitor all exits to ensure no unaccompanied children leave the premises.
- We will only serve in plastic glasses.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

We currently are using a class 2 monitoring device (Martindale SP79) to monitor the sound levels outside the closet house to the marque (located on green lane next to the rugby club) which we will log every 15 min. We also sometimes have access to a class 1 monitor however we use this a lot at weekends as this belongs to stadium weekender a festival company) However the system we use consists of 2 x Vonyx VSA 15 speakers which have a 500w amplifier built in, We have these speakers located at the end of the marquee facing away from the houses and pointing towards the pitch/ sea coast where they is no houses in that direction.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

The premises will operate a Challenge 25 policy, with all staff trained in age-verification and safeguarding procedures. Children will not be permitted in the bar or fanzone area unless accompanied by a responsible adult and if they are accompanied by an adult they would be out by 21:00 (unless it was a private function). A lost child procedure is in place, supported by stewarding, SIA security, and full CCTV coverage. The premises will refuse service to under-18s, anyone attempting proxy purchases, or anyone intoxicated, and will remove and report individuals engaging in antisocial or unlawful behaviour.

  - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
  - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
    - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
    - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the

relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
  - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
  - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
  - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
  - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
