



# Volunteer Role Description

## Guisborough Family Hub Sensory Playgroup Volunteer

This role involves supporting our Guisborough Family Hub, by running a monthly Saturday morning sensory play session. Ideally you will work alongside other volunteers in this role, however there may be occasions where you are the only volunteer onsite. The playgroup is fully inclusive open to all children, experience of working with or supporting children who have sensory needs/ASD would be helpful, (this could be as a parent or carer).

This opportunity will suit someone who:

- A real opportunity to experience working with children and young people.
- An opportunity to consider this as a future career option.
- Wants to make a difference to people's lives.
- An opportunity to learn new skills and share your knowledge with others.
- Get great experience to include on your CV or future application forms.
- Meet a range of new people and support children, parents and families.

The training programme for this role includes:

- Opening & Closing Guisborough Family Hub
- Safeguarding Training
- Prevent Training
- Additional In-house training is available (e.g. Infant Feeding – Level 2)

We require all volunteers to attend training as part of their role. This may be delivered in a range of ways including attending organised training sessions, work shadowing and through supervision. Training may be delivered at a range of venues.

This role requires a DBS check.
