Urgent - General Exception

Reason for urgency

The Saltburn Cliff Tramway Carriages are currently at the end of their life cycle and in a poor condition due to water ingress, rot, and internal fungi. The design, build and installation of replacement carriages are needed to bring the Grade II listed attraction back to a positive state of repair and to mitigate the risk of a forced closure. It will ensure that the Tramway can continue to operate safely whilst ensuring its significance as a dedicated heritage asset remains.

The reason for its urgency is due to the condition of the current carriages which have worsened far quicker than expected. Lead time for key materials and components are longer than anticipated. This urgency will ensure that the Tramway is fully operational by April 2026.

Background to decision:

The Saltburn Cliff Tramway Carriages are currently at the end of their life cycle and in a poor condition due to water ingress, rot and internal fungi. The design, build and installation of replacement carriages are needed to bring the Grade II listed attraction back to a positive state of repair and to mitigate the risk of a forced closure. It will ensure that the Tramway can continue to operate safely whilst ensuring its significance as a dedicated heritage asset remains.

The Grade II listed Saltburn Cliff Tramway is the Borough's main visitor attraction, attracting 184,000 visitors per year. It has been in operation since 1884 and is the oldest working funicular

in Great Britain and links the historic Victorian resort of Saltburn with the only remaining pleasure pier on the North East and Yorkshire Coast.

Rapid Consulting Engineers Ltd are the current contractor for the Saltburn Cliff Tramway and provide maintenance / emergency response and replacement parts as required. Their existing extensive and specialist knowledge of the carriages and the control system will support successful delivery of the project.

Decision Considerations:

If the carriages are not replaced this will force the Saltburn Cliff Tramway to close as the carriages will deteriorate further to the point where they are no longer fit for purpose or become unsafe to carry passengers causing significant reputational damage to the Council and a loss of income.

A Full Business Case for this investment was approved by Programme Management Group on 04/06/2025.

A Transparency Notice will be published to inform the market of the intention to award a contract for this requirement in accordance with the Procurement Act 2023.

Terms and Conditions will be agreed with Legal Services.
