Job interviews are a crucial part of the recruitment process, along with getting to know you as a person, recruiting managers use interviews to learn more about your background and skills and whether you'd be a good fit for their service. The aim of the following information is to provide you with some addition information prior to your interview.

#### Interview Questions

The questions you will be asked will be linked to the person specification, so read it again before you attend the interview. Think about the type of questions you will be asked and possible answers you could give that would support your application.

As an inclusive employer, it is the Council's policy to give the candidate the interview questions 15 minutes prior to their interview.

#### Reasonable Adjustment

Reasonable adjustments can be requested if you have a disability/health condition which may impact on your ability to perform at an interview. Example of reasonable adjustments include:

- Allowing you to take notes into your interview
- Allowing you additional time to respond to the questions
- Ensure that the interview venue is accessible
- Additional time to review the questions prior to your interview

#### Right to Work in the UK

To comply with the Asylum, Immigration and Nationality Act 2006, you will need to bring your current passport (we can accept this even if it has expired if we are able to prove the likeness). If you don't have a passport you will need to bring with you your original birth certificate and an official document that shows your National Insurance Number for example NI Card/Payslip/P45/P60
