A **variety of tasks** are available with dates to be agreed. Groups will be provided with a task supervisor, gloves and tools. No experience is necessary just lots of enthusiasm.

Some **tasks will involve** lifting and kneeling and most tasks require a good level of general health and fitness. Occasionally there may be a short walk to site. All work is outdoors with limited access to facilities.

Participants should wear old clothes and dress for the weather. Stout boots are recommended. They should bring a drink and lunch.

The day will be relaxed and fun with lots of opportunities to chat and participants will have the opportunity to make a positive difference in the local countryside whilst learning new skills.

Winter tasks, October – February 2024

Improving local footpaths – step building and vegetation management. Groups of between 6-15 are invited to help improve local paths in variety of tasks from clearing vegetation, building steps or surfacing paths. Available across a variety of locations

Woodland Management – improving local woodlands. Groups of between 6-30 are invited to help us manage local woodlands, picking up a variety of small tasks from managing invasive plants and shrubs, building habitat piles or installing interpretation to cutting back along access tracks

Hedge laying - Groups of between 3-8 are invited to help lay hedges. Hedge laying is a traditional method of managing hedgerows to keep them healthy and full to maintain important wildlife corridors and food and shelter for wildlife. Jan- March only
