In exercise of its powers under section 23 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Council proposes to install pedestrian crossings in the locations and of the type specified in the Schedule below.

SCHEDULE

Stokesley Road (West), Guisborough – Toucan Crossing The crossing is to be centred 32.8 metres west of its junction with Nightingale Road with a controlled area of 43.6 metres.

Stokesley Road (East), Guisborough – Toucan Crossing. The crossing is to be centred 62.6 metres east of its junction with The Avenue with a controlled area of 43.6 metres.

The Avenue, Guisborough – Parallel Crossing. The crossing is centred 14.6 metres south of its junction with Champion Drive with a controlled area of 41.4 metres.

The Avenue, Guisborough – Zebra Crossing. The crossing is to be centred 64.3 metres south of its junction with Sorrell Grove with a controlled area of 41.5 metres.

Hutton Lane, Guisborough – Toucan Crossing. The crossing is to be centred 40.2 metres north of its junction with Thames Avenue with a controlled area of 33.4 metres.
