



**REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT) ORDER NO 1 2026**

The Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) the effect of which will be to amend the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Order") by creating a new off street car park for permit holders only at Redcar Station Redcar.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to it, you may, within 6 weeks from 5.5.26 apply to the High Court for that purpose.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The Council has taken on the lease of Redcar Central Station and within the demise sits the access and parking bays to the front of the building. With refurbishment works to the building due for completion in December the council require the ability to safely manage and enforce vehicular movement in this area. It is intended to designate the parking area as permit holders only for the benefit of building tenants and visitors. There is ample public parking in the surrounding pay and display car parks.

In addition to the above, in accordance with section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the local authority, subject to Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to this Act, may by order make provision as to—

- (i) the use of the parking place, and in particular the vehicles or class of vehicles which may be entitled to use it,
- (ii) the conditions on which it may be used,
- (iii) the charges to be paid in connection with its use (where it is an off-street one), and
- (iv) the removal from it of a vehicle left there in contravention of the order and the safe custody of the vehicle

The Council of the Borough of Redcar and Cleveland (hereinafter called the “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called “The Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act , hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 2026 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places)(Consolidation)(Amendment)Order (No 1)2026
2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street parking Places)(Consolidation)Order 2003 (“the Order”) is hereby amended as follows:-

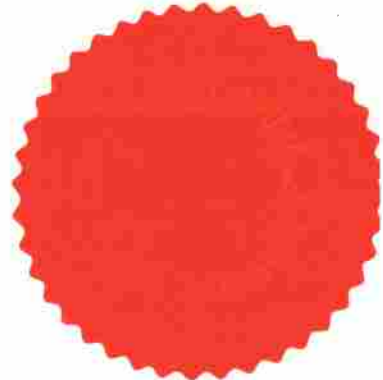
