Title: Short Breaks for Children and Young People with Disabilities and their Families Framework

Contract Reference: OPEN2025403

Description: The current Short Breaks for Children and Young People with Disabilities and their Families Framework commenced 1 April 2024 and will end on 31 March 2028.

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council wish to appoint Providers to the Framework for the provision of short breaks for children and young people with disabilities and their families.

Services are provided under the following Lots:

Lot 1 – Clubs.

Redcar and Cleveland commissioned clubs in local accessible venues identified by providers. Clubs may include but are not limited to after school clubs, weekend clubs and holiday clubs.

Lot 2 – Individual Support Services.

Individual Support Services that are personalised to meet an individual's needs and are usually provided as a solo service requiring 1:1 support or higher. Care and/or support can be provided in the family home or in the community.

Lot 3 – Overnight Support Away from Home.

Overnight support provided outside of the family home in a registered venue/home.

Lot 4 – Services in the Community.

Any community or outreach service that isn't covered in Lot 2 or 3 that could provide a specialist short break.
