This application for review is made on the grounds that the premises is failing to promote the licensing objectives, in particular:

- The prevention of crime and disorder
- Public safety
- The protection of children from harm

Cleveland Police have significant concerns regarding the management of the premises by both the premises licence holder (PLH) and the designated premises supervisor (DPS).

Between January and April 2026, incidents have occurred at the premises and it would be naïve to suggest that a licensed premises operating in the night time economy until 4am could be completely free of incidents, however there have been five serious incidents which have occurred during this time which are of great concern to Cleveland Police where any one of these incidents could easily have resulted in a fatality – These incidents include three serious assaults (one involving weapons and one involving a door staff member), one affray, and an incident in which an underage individual became ill whilst inside the premises believed to have been under the influence of drugs. Taken together these incidents demonstrate systemic failures in management, supervision, incident reporting, and the control of customers both inside the venue and in the immediate vicinity.

On 14 May 2026 Cleveland Police arranged a meeting with the DPS, the PLH, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] The DPS failed to attend and made no contact with Cleveland Police to explain her absence. During the meeting with the PLH Cleveland police attempted to introduce a development plan to address the concerns raised. However, the PLH's representative - [REDACTED] was argumentative, obstructive, and refused to accept responsibility for three of the incidents associated with the premises. [REDACTED] declined to agree to the development plan or any voluntary improvements, necessitating this application to review the premises licence.

Despite this intervention and the provision of the plan, the PLH is now failing to engage. Both the PLH and DPS deny any responsibility for two of the serious incidents, and the PLH was unaware that a further two had occurred, highlighting ineffective communication between the PLH and the DPS resulting in poor management overall.

Cleveland Police therefore request the revocation of the premises licence on the grounds that the PLH and DPS are failing to promote the licensing objectives and have demonstrated a fundamental lack of understanding of their legal responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003.
