



Volunteer Role Description

Learning and Engagement Volunteers

This role involves supporting our Museum Learning Team and Visitor Ambassadors to deliver our Learning and Engagement Offer and be part of our welcoming and friendly wider team. Volunteers are an important part of our team. We have a wide range of opportunities, supporting school and group learning sessions, community-based projects and workshops across the year, and particularly in term time through the week.

There will be opportunities to support the Learning Team to deliver group workshops, guided museum visits and craft activities in the museum and grounds. This will include events aimed at school children from Early Years through to post 16 yrs, SEND groups, Home Education families and adult audiences. You will work alongside other volunteers and our Creative Practitioner partners in this role. As a volunteer, you will also be ideally placed to promote volunteering opportunities within the museum service.

This opportunity will suit someone who:

- Has experience working with children and young people
- Wishes to learn about job roles and meet practitioners in the Museum services
- Wants to make a difference to people's lives, develop their cultural capital and support them to be creative.
- An opportunity to learn new skills and share your knowledge with others.
- Get great experience to include on your CV or future application forms.
- Meet a range of new people and support children, parents and families

The training programme for this role includes:

- Museum Induction including Basic Health & Safety
- Preparing and supporting or running a museum activity
- Safeguarding Training
- Manual handling training



- General Health and Safety
- Emergency First Aid (optional)
- Additional In-house training is available

This role requires a Enhanced DBS check.

We require all volunteers to attend training as part of their role. This may be delivered in a range of ways including attending organised training sessions, work shadowing and through supervision.
