



**REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT) ORDER NO 2 2025.**

The Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) the effect of which will be to amend the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Order") by adding The Way of St Hild Car Park Skinningrove and Beach Road Car Park Skinningrove to the Order and introducing limited waiting (4 hours maximum no return within 4 hours) in both car parks. Boats and tractors are exempt from the restriction.

The Order will come into operation on 5.6.26. A copy of the Order may be examined at the address below between the hours of 11am and 2.00pm Monday to Friday or at [Permanent highway notices | Redcar and Cleveland \(redcar-cleveland.gov.uk\)](#)

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision in it on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to it, you may, within 6 weeks from 3.6.26 apply to the High Court for that purpose.

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The existing off street car parks at Skinningrove are currently unrestricted; vehicles can park free of charge for an indefinite period. In order to assist in regulating parking within the car parks and ensure turnover of vehicles it is proposed to implement a 4-hour maximum stay with a no return period of 4 hours. The restriction will help prevent vehicles from parking up for prolonged periods and overnight whilst maintaining parking spaces for users wishing to access the beach and surrounding area. Beach Road park car park will have an exemption for boats.

In addition to the above, in accordance with section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,

the local authority, subject to Parts I to III of Schedule 9 to this Act, may by order make provision as to—

(i) the use of the parking place, and in particular the vehicles or class of vehicles which may be entitled to use it,

(ii) the conditions on which it may be used,

(iii) the charges to be paid in connection with its use (where it is an off-street one), and

(iv) the removal from it of a vehicle left there in contravention of the order and the safe custody of the vehicle

The Council of the Borough of Redcar and Cleveland (hereinafter called the “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called “The Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act , hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This order shall come into operation on the fifth day of June 2026 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places)(Consolidation)(Amendment)Order (No 2)2025
2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council(Off Street parking Places)(Consolidation)Order 2003 (“the Order”) is hereby amended as follows:-

The following words shall be added to the Off Street Car Park Schedule of the Order:-
