

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXTEND AND VARY “THE REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (GATES) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER (PSPO) 2017

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (the Council) hereby gives notice of its intention to extend and vary the above Public Spaces Protection Order under sections 59, 60 and 61 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act).

The Order shall be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Gates) Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO)

The effect of this extension and variation is the following:

1. The Order will be extended for a further 3 years ending on the 19th October 2029.
2. The Order will be varied to add an additional schedule into the PSPO, namely Schedule 16, restricting access to the following alleyways (as outlined on the attached Map):
 - Rears 4-30 Milbank Terrace REDCAR TS10 1ED
 - Rears 3-13 Queen Street REDCAR TS10 1DY
 - Rears 2B to 6-8 and side 10A West Dyke Road REDCAR TS10 1DZ
 - Sides 49 and 51 Station Road
 - Rear of 49B Station Road REDCAR TS10 1DT and;
 - Rears 43-47 Station Road, REDCAR TS10 1DT

The remainder of the Order will remain unchanged and can be viewed on the Council's website www.redcar-cleveland.gov.uk

If the proposed amendments are agreed, the Order will remain in force until 18th October 2029 unless extended and/or varied by further orders under the Council's Statutory powers.

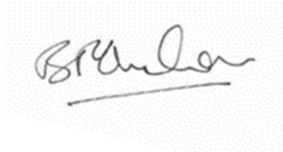
A person guilty of an offence under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum £100.

Copies of the Notice and map may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Kirkleatham Street, Redcar, Yorkshire, TS10 1RT between 09:00 and 17:00 Monday to Friday of any working week. Copies of the Notice and map may be bought there at a price of £1.50p or it can be viewed on the Council's website www.redcar-cleveland.gov.uk free of charge.

Any representations and/or objections regarding the proposals to amend the Order may be sent in writing to the council's prevention & partnership officer at Redcar &

Cleveland House, Kirkleatham Street, Redcar, Yorkshire TS10 1RT, no later than **7th October 2026**. Please state the grounds on which they are made. If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may extend and vary the Order.

If any such representations or objections are not withdrawn, the Council may still extend or vary the Order if it is appropriate for it to do so.
