

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXTEND AND VARY “THE REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL (ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR AND NUISANCE) PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER) (PSPO)”

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (the Council) hereby gives notice of its intention to extend and vary the above Public Spaces Protection Order under sections 59, 60 and 61 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act).

The Order shall be cited as the “Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Anti-Social Behaviour and Nuisance) Public Spaces Protection Order) (PSPO)”.

The effect of this extension and variation is the following:

1. The Order will be extended for a further 3 years ending on the 19th October 2029.
2. Subsections 4 and 5 of the Order are to be varied to form the following new offence (new subsection 4)

All persons are prohibited at any time from sitting, standing or loitering or being in possession of a receptacle used to obtain monies, for the purpose of asking for money or other objects or items in the restricted area. This includes the use of signage, children or animals.

3. Variation of the Marske Restricted Area (proposed new area shown on the attached map marked Marske PSPO) to include the following highways and open and amenity areas:

Highways:

152-206 High Street
Church Street
1-4 and 8-9 Church Lane
2-18 The Headlands

Open and amenity areas:

Valley Gardens

4. Variation of the Saltburn Restricted Area (proposed new area shown on the attached Map marked as Saltburn PSPO) to include the following highways and open and amenity areas:

Highways:

Marine Parade (seawards side)
Lower Promenade
Saltburn Bank

Open and amenity areas:

Marine Parade lower path gardens
Enclosed picnic area, Marine Parade
Grass and shrub-covered sea banks east of Hazel Grove ravine.

The remainder of the Order will remain unchanged and can viewed on the Council's website www.redcar-cleveland.gov.uk

If the proposed amendments are agreed, the Order will remain in force until 18th October 2029, unless extended and/or varied by further orders under the Council's Statutory powers.

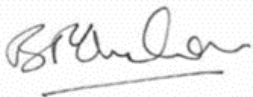
A person guilty of an offence under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a fixed penalty notice of a maximum of £100.

Any representations and/or objections regarding the proposals to amend the Order may be sent in writing to the council's prevention and partnership officer at Redcar & Cleveland House, Kirkleatham Street, Redcar, Yorkshire TS10 1RT, not later than **7th October 2026**. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

if no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may extend and vary the Order. If any such representations or objections are not withdrawn, the Council may still extend or vary the Order if it is appropriate for it to do so.
