



**THE REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL
(RESIDENT PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER (NO. 1) 2023**

The Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2003 by removing the central parking bay at The Crescent Redcar to allow parking for those wishing to attend the church or access the parks and allotments. The resident bays either side directly outside of the residential properties will remain as resident only.
